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Miele Cube and Cube X small sterilisers: more flexible and convenient than ever before

- ▶ New rotating holder for containers and cartridges with a max. height of 70 mm
- ▶ Water treatment shared by thermal disinfectors and small sterilisers

Gütersloh/Cologne, September 22, 2021. – Two years after their market launch, four Miele Cube and Cube X small sterilisers ensure even greater user convenience and further simplify the reprocessing of instruments in dental practices: with a flexible holder for containers and cartridges, a connection to Miele full demineralisation cartridges and an updated app for the wireless documentation of reprocessing.

The new holder is available for all Cube and Cube X models and accommodates either two containers and cartridges with a maximum height of 70 mm or, alternatively, five additional standard trays. This addresses a variety of reprocessing requirements.

Charging the water tank remains flexible as it can be done either manually or automatically via the water treatment system connection. Practices which combine the use of a Cube or Cube X unit with a Miele thermal disinfectant and hence require increased volumes of demineralised water now see their needs met fast in the form of Miele full demineralisation cartridges. An appropriate set of fittings for connection is now available with immediate effect for small sterilisers.

Further development work on Miele's DataDiary app now allows it to process information from up to 9 sterilisers. Data is transferred wirelessly to a tablet PC – without any further involvement on the part of staff. DataDiary also takes care of reprocessing records - automatically and in a time-saving way. The app, which can also be used on thermal disinfectors, has been updated to run on both Android and iOS.

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Company profile: Miele is the world's leading manufacturer of premium domestic appliances including cooking, baking and steam-cooking appliances, refrigeration products, coffee makers, dishwashers and laundry and floor care products. Their product portfolio also includes dishwashers, air purifiers, washing machines and tumble dryers for commercial use as well as washer-disinfectors and sterilisers for use in medical and laboratory applications (Miele Professional). Founded in 1899, the company has eight production plants in Germany, one each in Austria, the Czech Republic, China, Romania and Poland as well as two production plants belonging to its Italian medical technology subsidiary Steelco. Sales in the 2020 business year amounted to around € 4.5 bn (thereof 29.5% in Germany). Miele is represented with its own sales subsidiaries and via importers in almost 100 countries/regions. Throughout the world, the family-run enterprise, now in its fourth generation, employs a workforce of around 20,900, of which approx. 11,050 employees work in Germany. The company has its headquarters in Gütersloh in Westphalia.
