Another standout feature is the "Freeze&Cool" function, which allows part of the appliance to be used flexibly as either a fridge or freezer. The ice and water dispenser provides filtered refreshment, while high-quality glass surfaces make a stylish statement in any modern kitchen. Ideal for families who value both design and convenience.

With the third generation of its MasterCool series, Miele sets new standards in refrigeration. The interior made of brushed stainless steel is not only visually impressive but also hygienic and durable.
